

Student Supply Lists 2008-2009

Grades Six - Eight

The middle school teachers have seen a need for students to maintain a clear system for organizing their school papers, assignments, and supplies. Instead of leaving the system to chance, or to whatever may be the latest offerings at the stores, the teachers are requiring everyone to have the same system. By encouraging the use of this system, the teachers (and parents) can expect to see homework found more readily, papers to parents delivered more efficiently, and everyone happier!

Supplies needed:

4 spiral bound notebooks with perforated pages

3-ring binder with a zippered case (Trapper Keeper or similar)

Divider pages with tabs/one for each subject (Gr. 6 needs 11, Gr. 7 & 8 need 13)

2 portfolio pocket folders with 3 holes for binder.

You may choose either plain or designed, but make sure design is appropriate for school.

1 pkg. college-ruled notebook paper

#2 pencils (your choice of regular or mechanical)

Black or dark blue smooth-writing pens. No gel pens, please.

1 red pen

Compass with locking radius (6th Grade only)

Protractor (6th Grade only)

4 composition notebooks for Math, English, and Bible journals, and Science Labs.

12" ruler with inches and centimeters

1 bottle or pen of White Out or Liquid Paper

Eraser

Colored pencils

1 pkg. lined white 3x5 index cards

Scissors

Texas Instruments calculator: TI-30XA (about \$10-\$15)

1 pkg. graph paper (4 or 5-squares/inch)

Zippered case (if one is not part of binder) that clips into Trapper to hold pencils, pens, etc.

Pocket dictionary (American Heritage dictionary is a good one)

1 package tracing paper

2 boxes of tissues to be donated to the classroom

2 packages of refill baby wipes

Book covers for approx. 6-8 books; **brown paper bags recommended**, instruction provided (not adhesive, non-fabric)

NIV Study Bible from Zondervan Publishing Company (softcover @ \$18; hardcover @ \$30) OR NIV Student Bible

For students taking Spanish: Merriam-Webster Diccionaria Espanol-Ingles (\$5.99; 2001 publication)

For students taking French: Larousse 9or any other) francais-anglais pocket dictionary

Students will be required to use the assignment notebook provided by the school.

Locker shelf

Magnetic White board for locker and dry erase marker

Note: These supplies do not need to be new. They need to be on hand on the first day of school. The teachers will help students set up their binders during homeroom on the first day.
