

High School Supply List

All items do NOT need to be new if you've already purchased them in a previous year.

Some class-specific supplies may need to be purchased in the first week of the school year.

- 6 spiral bound, 3-hole notebooks with perforated pages
- A paper organizational system. A 2" binder with divided pages; tabs/one for each subject works well. You may prefer two 1" binders or an accordion file
- 1 pkg. college-ruled notebook paper
- 3 bound 10inch by 7inch (or any size close to that) composition books
- Writing Utensil Case filled with:
 - #2 pencils (your choice of regular or mechanical)
 - Black or dark blue smooth-writing pens. No gel pens, please.
 - Colored pencils
 - Erasers
- Calculator: Texas Instruments TI-30X IIS Scientific (\$10.00) – *Freshmen*
- Calculator: Texas Instruments **TI-83 or higher** – *Sophomores - Seniors*
- Compass, Protractor (*for Geometry students*)
- 12" ruler with inches and centimeters
- 1 pkg. lined white 3x5 index cards
- Scissors
- 1 pkg. graph paper (4 or 5-squares/inch)
- Pocket dictionary (American Heritage dictionary is a good one)
- 2 boxes of tissues to be donated to the classroom
- Book covers for approx. 6-8 books (not adhesive, no "book sox"; fabric is allowed; paper bags work well)
- Personal Bible – any translation
- For students taking Spanish: Merriam-Webster Diccionaria Espanol-Ingles
- For those students taking French: Larousse (or any other) Francais-Anglais pocket dictionary.
